Williams Scholarship has been awarded to co-winners Selena Wilson, P.Eng. of McElhanney Consulting Services Ltd. and Simon Davidson, P.Eng. of Roche Ltd., Consulting Group. Ms. Wilson and Mr. Davidson were presented with their awards at the ACEC's national Summit in Lake Louise, Alberta on June 21, 2013.

The Allen D. Williams Scholarship is presented annually to a Young Professional employed by an ACEC member firm who demonstrates a commitment to the consulting engineering industry in their province or territory.

Selena Wilson is a Transportation Engineer at McElhanney Consulting Services Ltd. She has served as a steering committee member with the ACEC-BC Young Professional (YP) Group, the ACEC YP Network, and the International Federation of Consulting Engineers (FIDIC) YP Forum Steering Committee. Most recently, she was elected Chair of the Steering Committee serving a two-year term that will conclude at FIDIC's 2014 annual conference.

Simon Davidson is a Project Manager with Roche Ltd. and manager of Roche's start-up office in Ottawa-Gatineau. He is the Founder and Chair of the Roche Young Leader Network and Co-founder and current Chair of the Association des ingénieurs-conseils du Québec (AICQ) YP Forum, as well as Chair of the ACEC YP Network. He is a member of the FIDIC YP steering committee and instigator of a new international training platform for YPs within FIDIC.

The scholarship commemorates Allen Williams, past ACEC Chair and Founder of Williams Engineering Inc. It provides the winner with funding to cover registration, airfare and accommodations to attend FIDIC's annual conference. The 2014 FIDIC conference will be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
