Consulting Engineers from Quebec City Help Protect Coasts from Erosion in Bénin, Africa

(OTTAWA) October 25, 2016 – Consulting engineers from Quebec City firm Norda Stelo conducted a major coastal protection project in Cotonou, Bénin for which they won an Award of Excellence Tuesday night at the 2016 Canadian Consulting Engineering (CCE) Awards gala. This well-deserved award was bestowed to Norda Stelo for this international project's technical excellence and its social, economic and environmental contribution to the community in which it was carried out.



“These awards showcase the outstanding talent and expertise of consulting engineers across Canada,” said ACEC President and CEO John Gamble. “By recognizing projects with national awards, we highlight the important contributions of engineering firms to Canadians and the huge impact they have both here at home and around the world.”

Saving disappearing shorelines

In Cotonou, Bénin, approximately 13 metres of shoreline used to disappear each year due to erosion caused by the sea. This had serious consequences for the densely populated surrounding area. Under the auspices of international funding to combat and adapt to climate change, Norda Stelo and its partners carried out work to stop the advancing sea and rehabilitate banks. The project took place over a six-year period and cost nearly \$100 million US to complete.

“This award has special significance for Norda Stelo, because it recognizes our involvement in promoting Canadian engineering expertise through sharing knowledge and know-how, essential tools for building high-quality infrastructure, but especially for forging a better tomorrow for developing countries,” said Alex Brisson, President and Chief Executive Officer of Norda Stelo.

Thanks to the quality of construction work, a major rehabilitation of the banks is already noticeable and local economic and social activities that were once threatened by the dangers of erosion are preserved. This project also generated numerous local jobs in Cotonou and provided workers with valuable training and experience. Twenty Beninese workers, including 8 engineers and several technicians even joined the Norda Stelo project team. In addition to ensuring community safety, environmental integrity was maintained in order to preserve the coastal ecosystem. The Norda Stelo team conducted studies to ensure that terrestrial and maritime habitats and species, especially various threatened sea turtle species, were protected and environmental measures were implemented to reduce anticipated impacts.
